

DronTech Asia 2025: Advancing Regional Leadership in Unmanned Systems and Innovation

DronTech Asia 2025 concluded with resounding success at the Malaysia International Trade and Exhibition Centre (MITEC), Kuala Lumpur, reinforcing its position as the region’s ultimate platform for the drone and unmanned systems industry.

This year’s edition brought together 3,923 industry professionals, 242 conference delegates, and 75 participating companies from 11 countries, representing every facet of the rapidly expanding low-altitude economy. Over three days, the event served as a powerful convergence point for government agencies, regulators, industry leaders, and technology innovators to exchange insights, explore partnerships, and drive forward the collective growth of the regional ecosystem.

Anchored by the theme “Pushing the Boundaries of Innovation and Technology,” DronTech Asia 2025 showcased the sector’s rapid evolution through high-level exhibitions, and strategic conferences led by global experts. Attendees experienced first-hand the latest advancements transforming key industries from agriculture, energy, and infrastructure to logistics, security, and urban air mobility, demonstrating how drones are revolutionising productivity, operational efficiency, and sustainability across borders.

As Malaysia assumed the ASEAN Chairmanship in 2025, DronTech Asia has proven to be the definitive meeting point for innovation, collaboration, and policy dialogue in the unmanned systems industry. The event underscores Malaysia’s growing leadership and commitment to strengthening regulatory frameworks, fostering regional partnerships, and positioning itself as the hub for unmanned systems development and investment across Asia.

Globally, PwC estimates the drone economy will unlock USD127 billion annually, while China projects its low-altitude economy to exceed USD420 billion by 2030. From agriculture and logistics to defence, smart cities and medical response, these technologies are no longer experimental — they are reshaping entire industries. For Malaysia, the potential is clear. Drones and advanced air mobility open doors to new markets, new streams of investment, and high-value careers for Malaysians. Recognising this, both the Malaysian Aerospace Industry Blueprint 2030 (MAIB 2030) and the New Industrial Master Plan 2030 (NIMP 2030) embed drones and AAM as key growth drivers, ensuring the nation positions itself as a hub for innovation, regulation and talent.
